

Naming



emacs-foo

-Where foo is the add-on's name

BuildRequires, Requires, Arch

- BuildRequires: emacs
- Requires: emacs(bin) >= %{_emacs_version}
- BuildArch: Noarch

Directories



`%{_emacs_sitelispdir}` - /usr/share/emacs/site-lisp

`%{_emacs_sitestartdir}` - /usr/share/emacs/site-lisp/site-start.d

Bytecompile aka build



`%{_emacs_bytecompile}`

Subpackage
